Municipal low-cost energy efficiency measures to alleviate energy poverty
(EnPover Municipalities)

Duration: October 2019 – March 2021

Implementer: Association of Municipalities Polish Network "Energie Citēs"

Countries of implementation: Poland, Hungary, Germany

Partners: Energiaklub and Deutsche Umwelthilfe

Goals:

- to alleviate energy poverty by boosting implementation of low-cost energy efficiency measures in vulnerable households,
- to activate and empower municipal actors to initiate local support schemes addressing vulnerable households.

This will be achieved through:

- establishing network of municipal professionals interested in advancing EE measures in private households,
- collecting and exchanging best-practice examples of local initiatives supporting energy poor households,
- building capacities and skills of municipal staff during series of dedicated workshops and inspiring study visits,
- creating a toolkit of customized support schemes,
- kick-starting model energy awareness raising campaigns.

Results:

- reduction of GHG emissions from private households within participating municipalities and beyond due to the uptake and wider dissemination of individual low-cost energy efficiency measures (technical and social, i.e. behavioural changes), initiated and supported by local authorities,
- alleviation of energy poverty in low- and middle-income households due to targeted measures for the most vulnerable.
